Always follow the instructions in the manual that came with your individual crib, as instructions and crib parts may vary. If your crib is not a convertible crib and was not intended to convert to a toddler bed, dont attempt to make it into a toddler bed! Dont use a power screwdriver! Remove the stationary side. Move the cribs spring frame to the lowest level, if it isnt there already. Secure the frame with the same bolts and washers that were already holding it in place. Mount the guardrail to the front panel of the crib. It doesnt matter where you attach the high part of the guardrail. Attach the guardrail using the bolts provided for this purpose. Do not overtighten the screws and bolts, as this may cause breakage or distortion of the wood. Contact the manufacturer for a replacement part. This way, your wallet and your growing child will thank you. Some parents may say it's best to convert once your child gets the hang of climbing out of the crib. Others focus on their child's size, converting when they look like they could use a bit more space and flexibility to get in and out on their own. Some are two in one or even three in one, allowing you to take the bed up to youth sizes. This includes a toddler bed rail. If yours did not come with one, it's simple enough to purchase it online or in the store. It shouldn't hinder your child's access or exit from the bed. You can find a universal toddler guardrail kit since they are specifically designed to fit most mainstream cribs with no problems. If you can't remove the mattress without removing the dropside, proceed to the next step first and then clear the crib out. The toddler guardrail is intended to replace that. However, other models require tools. It's still easy as you just need to remove screws from either side using a screwdriver, electric or manual. If this is the case, follow the instructions on removing the dropside and carry on. Your guardrail should have come with the necessary brackets to mount. If they didn't, be sure to purchase the required hardware. A manual screwdriver will do the trick here. The end posts and brackets should line up on two different slats on the crib. Generally, rails are somewhere in the middle. To convert crib to toddler bed in this case, make sure there's enough room for your child to get in and out. About 89in.

space from the rail to the headboard and the rail to the footboard is enough. There's little difference beyond cosmetic. When everything is screwed on, attempt to move the rail around. However, an obvious wobble means that the rail is not attached tight enough. If this is the case, go back and check all of your screws to make sure everything is as it should be. You may need to opt for a different model. For those of you that just want to remove the other side without giving your kid access to it, move the bed against the wall to keep them from falling out. Your budding toddler now has an appropriate, safe bed to sleep in and jump out to explore all they want. If you have a stationary crib and wish to still make use of it, then DIY is your best bet. There is sawing that will take place, so it might be best to do this far away from your baby's room such as the garage or somewhere else outdoors. That way, everything you need to saw or unscrew is clear. You'll move the base and sides to their highest point instead. If you do this, you'll need a ladder for your child. You can trim it, but you'll have to work carefully so you won't cut something you'll need. This way, you won't risk any damage to the crib. When trimming, the new edge should remain flush with the vertical slats.

You can also install an Lbracket to the edge of the rail. This ensures your little one won't break it no matter the amount of pressure they put. If you're opting for the loftstyle, then head to the next step. From there, gather two pieces of sturdy wood such as pallet wood. Cut at an angle, preferably 45degrees, so the bottom edge is flush with the floor. Create grooves the size of the rungs in the ladder with the router. Wood glue will secure it all. If not, add some screws. Always test the ladder to make sure it won't move around. If you want to keep up with them, give them the first taste of true independence by setting up a toddler bed. To convert the bed from a crib to a toddler bed will take about 30 minutes. Insert the Allen key into each of the four bolts and turn counterclockwise to loosen the bolts. Because you will be reinstalling the crib legs, you do not need to fully remove the bolts from the side panels. Each leg is held in place by one bolt along the top rail and another near the bottom of the rail assembly. These will be easy to remove if you grab them with a pliers and gently pull them out. Line up the metal pins to the holes in the side rail and gently push on the legs to hold them in place. Tighten the Allen bolts by turning the Allen key clockwise. The cribs are made from solid New Zealand pine responsibly sourced and produced in Vietnam. This includes the dressers, toppers and night tables. All of the drawers are made with solid wood and the extension kits are made from plywood with New Zealand Pine veneers.

Drawer front panels, dresser rear center panels, top panels, and side panels are made from MDF that do not contain formaldehyde. All knobs are made of brushed nickel. The juvenile beds are made from solid Rubber Wood responsibly sourced and produced in Vietnam. The bunk beds are made from the same responsibly sourced type of materials but, they are sourced and produced in Indonesia. The bunk railings are made from solid Rubber Wood, the stairs and bookcase are made from MDF with a particleboard core covered in Mahogany veneers. The MDF does not contain formaldehyde. The drawer handles are made from Aluminum with powder coats. The contour pads included with all dressers are made of 100% durable quilted vinyl with a 1" curving to 4" foam pad and contoured edges for added safety. The bottom of the pad has nonskidded foam and the pad has a safety strap with a quick release buckle. Additional straps are included to fasten to the back of the dresser. Does the crib, bed or bunk bed come with a mattress or box spring. The beds, cribs and bunk beds do not include a mattress. The cribs include a mattress support which can be adjusted to three different heights so a second mattress is not required but, a box spring is. All of the upper and lower bunks of our collections include a complete slat roll system so a box spring is not required. What size mattress do I need to buy. All cribs may be purchased with the extension kit to convert the crib into a full double sized bed. A standard double size mattress will fit into the full bed. The bunk beds maximum recommended mattress height in the upper bunk is 6" as per Health Canada. Health

Canada recommends that bunk beds meet the safety requirements of American standards ASTM F142796, and 16 CFR, Parts 1213, 1500 and 1513. All bunk beds are tested to comply with these standards. A standard double sized mattress fits into the juvenile beds. What size sheets do I have to buy for the crib.

Place the mattress support in its lowest position as soon as your baby can push up on his or her hands and knees. Avoid the use of loose bedding or soft objects in your baby's crib. Things like comforters, quilts, blankets, infant pillows, adult pillows, foam padding, stuffed toys, bumper pads and sleep positioners should not be in your baby's sleeping area. Remove mobiles and toy bars as soon as your baby begins to push up on his or her hands and knees. What are the weight limits of the toddler bed. The minimum age required for the converted toddler bed is 18 months old. The maximum weight capacity is 22 kilograms 50 lbs. Does the crib come with the extension kit and toddler guard rail. The crib can be purchased with the extension kit or without. All of the 31 convertible cribs include both the extension kit and the toddler guard rails. Extension kits can be sold separately. What are the weight limits of the bunk beds. The Minimum age recommended for any upper bunk bed is six years old. The maximum recommended weight supported in the upper bunk is 200 lbs. The maximum recommended weight for the bottom bunk bed is 360lbs. For safety reasons, please never allow two children to share the upper bunk bed even if they both weigh less combined than the maximum recommended weight. The issue can be resolved by having one person lift the bunk frame up to meet the holes of the stairs and then insert the bolts into place. If the trundle is going to be used as a bed the child's weight, combined with the mattress can not exceed the limit. My furniture smells, what is that and how can I get rid of it. This is not common with our line of products but, it can happen with new furniture. If you notice that the new furniture purchased from us is emitting a discomforting odor, do not be concerned, this is known as "off gassing". There is nothing to worry about; the smell will not harm you or your child. Caramia Furniture does not use paints that contain formaldehyde, or other harmful chemicals. The smell occurs when the product does not have enough time to dry in the factory after being painted. The best way to get rid of the odor is to place the product in a wellventilated room for a few days with the drawers and everything open.

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Ventilation alone should do the trick in most cases. If the smell is persistent, the manufacturer suggests cleaning the furniture with a lemon scented name brand furniture cleaner or a home made vinegar and baking soda solution. Why is this happening. In order to keep children safe, all drawer gliders had rubber stoppers placed in them as a safety feature in order to prevent children from opening the drawers on their own and potentially tipping the whole unit over. In order for the drawers to be completely shut, you need to push them in until you hear a click or pop sound. This way you can ensure that the rubber stopper is engaged. It will take some time to loosen the gliders, stiffness when open and closing the drawers will disappear after some time of constant use. If that wont work or if you want to embark on a more advanced project, you can trim down one of the existing sides into a toddler railing, instead. Unless your childs crib came with its own toddler bed rail, youll need to purchase a separate rail. Your toddler should be able to get in and out of bed without assistance, but the rail should prevent your toddler from accidentally rolling out of bed in his or her sleep. The rail itself should fit most recently manufactured cribs, and the kit will also contain the metal brackets and screws youll need to attach the rail. Use a manual or electric screwdriver to remove the screws holding one side of the crib in place. If you choose to remove both sides, youll need to install a toddler rail on either side or push one side of the bed against a wall. Stationary cribs do not have removable sides, so you wont be able to use this method of conversion.

Since the dimensions of the bed wont change after you convert it, you should be able to use the same mattress and sheets. Position one Lbracket along the inside of each rail post. Attach the brackets to the posts using screws and a screwdriver. The vertical portion of the bracket should be aligned with the center of the post. Use two screws to secure the bracket to the post. You should also leave another 9 inches 23 cm of space in between the rail and the footboard. Try to keep the bracket positioned down the center of each corresponding slat for the greatest amount of security. When finished, try to wiggle the rail. The guardrail should not move. Cover it with sheets, blankets, and pillows as needed. The toddler bed should now be ready to use. Install both rails before returning the mattress and bedding. Youll need direct access to all sides of the crib, including the bottom, and the bedding will only get in the way. Sawdust and other particles may get into the bedding if you keep it nearby. Note that youll also need to create a ladder for your toddler to use if you opt for a loftstyle bed. Use a saw to cut an opening into one of the long sides of the crib. Otherwise, youll need to work carefully to avoid damaging the remainder of the crib. This slat will become the new side edge of the rail. If desired, you can also use a portion of the removed rail to finish off the new edge. Make sure that the rail is sturdy and unable to wiggle around before continuing. Use a saw to trim down the slats of the removed railing. The new length of these slats should roughly match the size of the opening you created in the side of the bed. These newly trimmed slats will form the rungs or steps of the ladder. Each of the slats must also be equal in length. Cut a length of sturdy wood into two equal pieces. These pieces will form the sides of the ladder.

Measure the distance between the bottom of the bed and the floor, holding the measuring stick at a 45 degree angle so that it juts out and away from the side of the bed. Doing so will allow the ladder sides to rest evenly on the floor. These notches should be the size and shape of the step pieces you cut earlier. Try to match the size as evenly as possible to keep the steps more secure. These notches should allow the side pieces to fit over the bottom side of the bed. Slide the step pieces into the notches positioned along the ladder sides. Hold the step pieces in place using wood glue. If they still dont seem secure, install nails or screws into each step from the outside to fix them to the ladder sides. When finished, the steps should not be able to wiggle around. Attach the top of the ladder to the bottom of the bed using wood glue and screws. Make sure that it does not move around when

you apply pressure. Screw a corner bracket over the edge of the guardrail. Secure one side of the bracket to a slat along the underside of the bed and the other side of the bracket to the outermost rail post. Use 1 inch 2.5 cm Phillipshead screws in each of the four screw holes. Your toddler will likely grab onto this side of the rail when getting into bed, creating excess pressure on it, and the rail could collapse if it isn't properly strengthened. One way is to remove one side of the crib with a screwdriver and attach a premade guardrail in its place. Alternatively, you can unscrew the crib's base and reattach it higher up.
